

Mark's Gospel - Bible Training Guide

Mark's Gospel was the first Gospel to be written. "Gospel" means "Good News" about Jesus Christ. Mark was one of the leaders of the early Church and worked with Peter the apostle. In his Gospel Mark shows that Jesus is the rightful King of the world. The word "Christ" means "King" - literally "anointed" - ("Messiah" in Hebrew) which is the way a king was appointed. He was anointed with the Holy Spirit at His baptism. Chapter	What it teaches about Jesus Christ	Commands or examples to follow	What I will do and who I will share with
1		Verse 15 Turn to God and believe that Jesus is the King sent by God Verse 17 follow Jesus Christ and become a fisher of men	
2		-Ask Jesus Christ for healing and forgiveness.	
3		-Do good even when it is costly	
4		Verse 9 Really pay attention to what Jesus says. Suggestion: Read the Bible each day, drawing out a lesson and seeking to follow that. -Recognise that Jesus Christ has power over the wind and sea and all creation.	
5		Verse 19 Tell others what the Lord has done for you	
6		-Anoint people with oil in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, asking Him to heal them (verse 13).	
7		Verses 14-22: Cleanse hearts from evil thoughts – sex outside marriage, theft, murder, adultery, greed, malice, deceit, uncontrolled fleshly appetites, envy, slander, arrogance and folly -Beware of adding traditions and other practices to the Bible (v.8)	
8		Verses 34-38 Follow Jesus even at the cost of our own lives	

9		Verses 35-37 Always take the role of a servant to everyone, and welcome the humblest; 42-49 Avoid things that cause sin; 50 be at peace with others.	
10		Verse 9 No divorce; 14 Do not hinder children coming to the Lord; 19 no murder, adultery, stealing, lying or defrauding; honour father and mother; 21 sell possessions and give to poor; 43-44 be servant of all.	
11		Verse 22 have faith in God; 24 whatever you ask in prayer, believe that you have received it; 25 forgive others -Prayer each day	
12		Verse 17 Obey the state when it does not contradict God; 29-30 Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, mind and strength; 31 Seek the good of others as much as of yourself; 38-40 Beware of hypocrisy -Giving (as the widow in 41-44)	
13		Verse 7 not alarmed; 9 fearless in witnessing; 11 not worry what to say; 18 pray for help in distress; 21-23 not deceived by false Messiahs; 28-37 be alert for the Lord's coming	
14		Verses 22-24 Remember Jesus's death by eating bread - His body and drinking wine - His blood, meeting with fellow Christians; 38 Watch in prayer Suggestions: - Pray as a family and give thanks before meals	
15		-Thank Jesus Christ for suffering and dying for us.	
16		Verse 15 Go into all the world and preach the Good News to all people; 16 Believe and be baptized - Be baptized and receive the Holy Spirit
